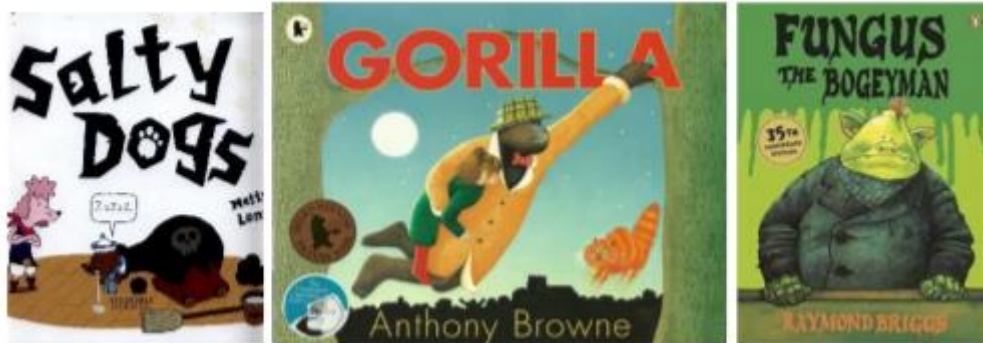


## Developing reader/ Moderately Fluent – Year 2/3
