Eco-Schools Topic	CREATE A MURAL FROM RECYCLED PLASTIC
Aim	Raise awareness and knowledge of plastic pollution/ pollution issues e.g. lifecycle of plastic, Impact of plastic pollution, how human behaviours contribute to environmental damage
Action(s)	<p><i>Spring 1 2026</i> Research plastic pollution and how it impacts sea-life Adopt a whale via WWF to help raise the seriousness of plastic pollution and its impact. Communicate the project in assembly - Raise awareness of what single-use plastics are and give examples (concrete objects to make it memorable)</p> <p><i>Spring 2 2026</i> Design and create a mural with a powerful message relating to marine life - gather a collection of plastic and set up a donation station</p> <p><i>Summer 1 2026</i> Finishing touches to mural Have an assembly and big reveal (invite a school Governor and School Improvement Partner) of the art piece Feature this with an impactful message in the school newsletter Mention green careers in a whole school assembly Investigate which single-use plastics are used in your school - identify which items could be removed/restricted Additionally, ECO Committee plan and create a re-cycling Centre on-site with the possibility of children bringing specific plastic items from home and a community - street recycling day per term for neighbours</p>
Informing & Involving	Inform SLT and Head of school Inform pupils through assemblies Involve the whole school in plastic donation station, green career awareness and limiting usage of single use plastics Involve all children and possibly neighbours in recycling scheme
